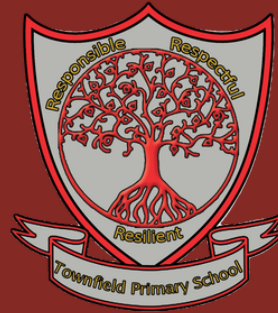

Please take a moment to click on the link in the picture and share your thoughts. Your input is so important, and I look forward to hearing all of your ideas.

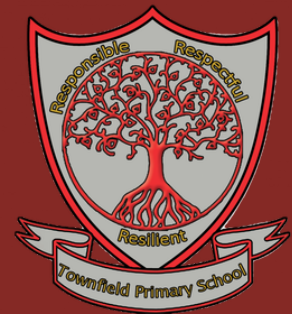


## YEAR 6 LEADERSHIP TEAM

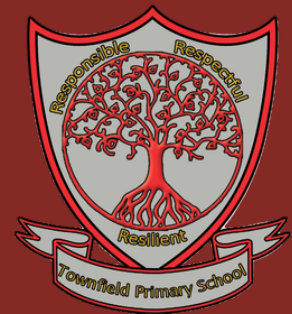
## INSTAGRAM

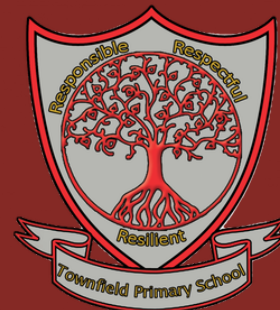
## VOLUNTEERS FOR MABEL
