We want to continue giving you opportunities to share your suggestions throughout the year, so we have created a "Townfield Wish Box" in our reception area. We welcome all of your ideas!

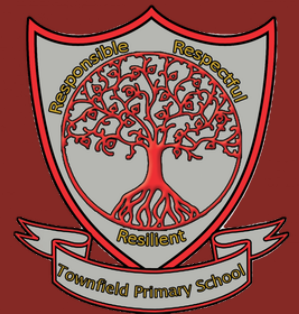


## THE DOG'S DEN

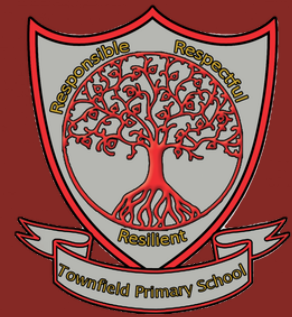
## TECHNOLOGY CORNER

We are absolutely thrilled to announce our special, one-off, super-duper fun 'McTownfield' Themed Lunch happening on Thursday, 2nd October!

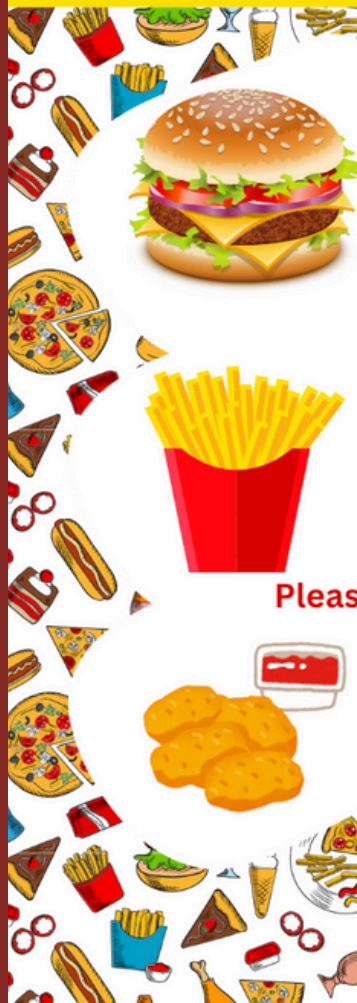

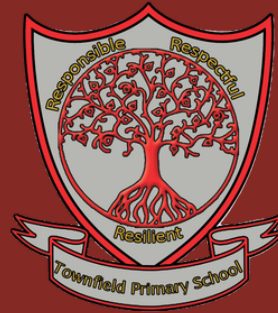

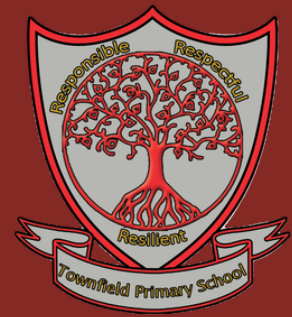
## WORLD MENTAL HEALTH DAY FRIDAY 10<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER

**Friendship and Trust:** Being kind and honest.

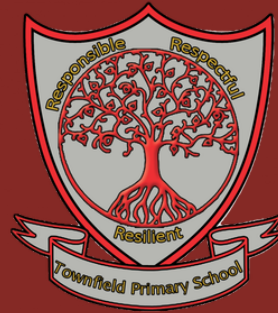
**Endurance:** Keeping going even when things are tough.

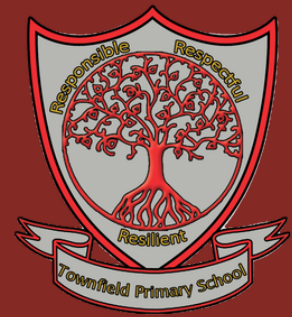

## NASAL FLU VACCINATION FRIDAY 3<sup>RD</sup> OCTOBER

The children's nasal spray flu vaccine is safe and effective. It's offered every year to primary age children Nursery to Year 6 to help protect them against flu.

Flu is caused by the influenza virus and can be a very unpleasant illness for children. It can also lead to serious problems such as bronchitis and pneumonia.

Children can catch and spread flu easily. Vaccinating them also protects others who are vulnerable to flu, such as young babies and older people.
