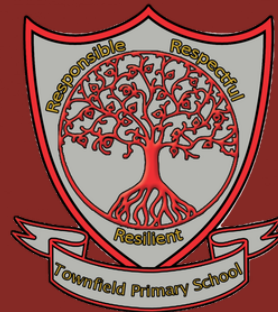

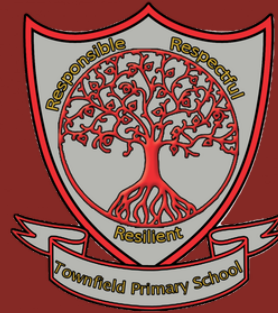
On the catering side, our McTownfield lunch was a fabulous success and enjoyed by all the children—a big thank you to our kitchen team!

We are so excited to read the stories that your children will create!

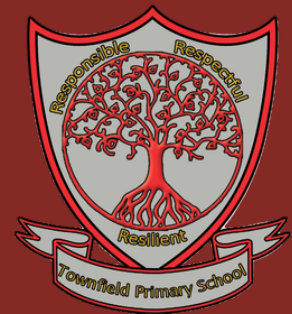


## WORLD MENTAL HEALTH DAY FRIDAY 10<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER

Donations will be presented during our Harvest Service on 15<sup>th</sup> October and then delivered to Forum Housing Association.

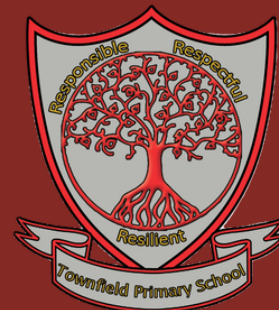

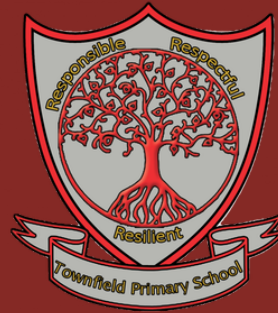
## HELLO FROM MR CHALMERS

Years 3 & 4 4.00pm - 4.45pm (Enter and pick up via the front office doors)

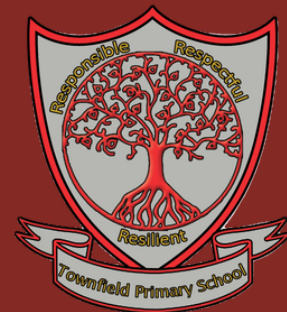
Years 5 & 6 5.00pm - 5.45pm (Enter and pick up via the front office doors)

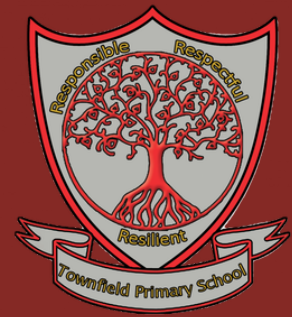

**Friendship and Trust:** Being kind and honest.

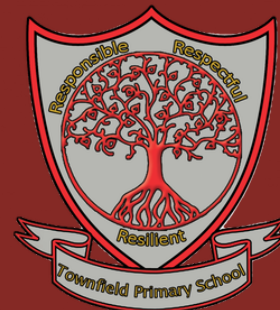
**Endurance:** Keeping going even when things are tough.

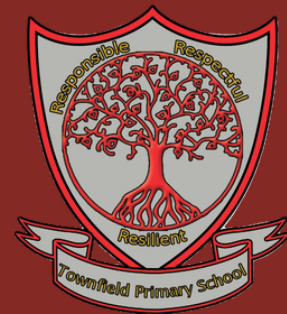

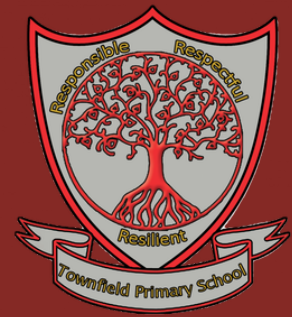

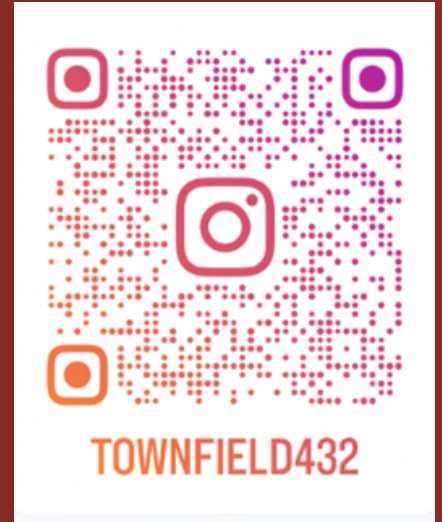
