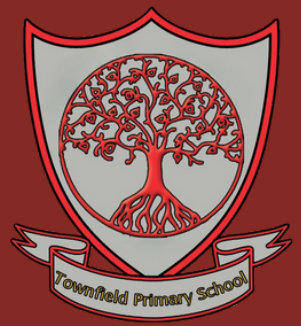




MESSAGE FROM MRS DURHAM

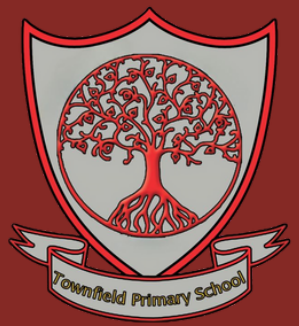

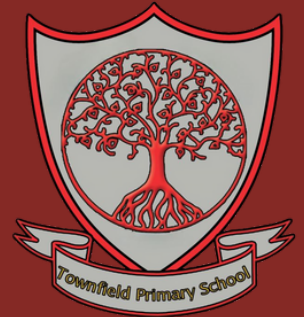
REINDEER RAMBLE

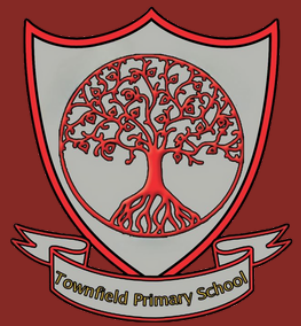
EYFS NEWS

CHRISTMAS DINNER DAY

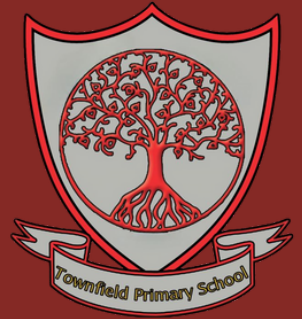
Thursday 11th December was the annual Christmas dinner day and Christmas jumper day.

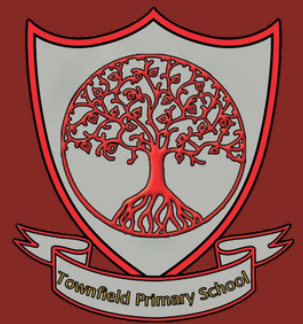
EYFS STAY AND PLAY

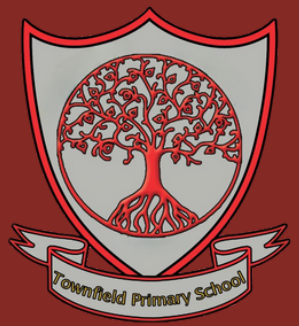

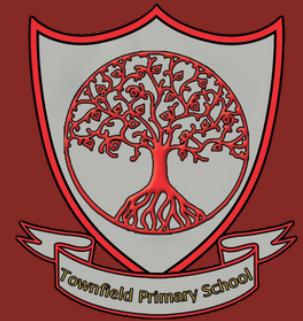

We are incredibly proud of all the students who have shown:

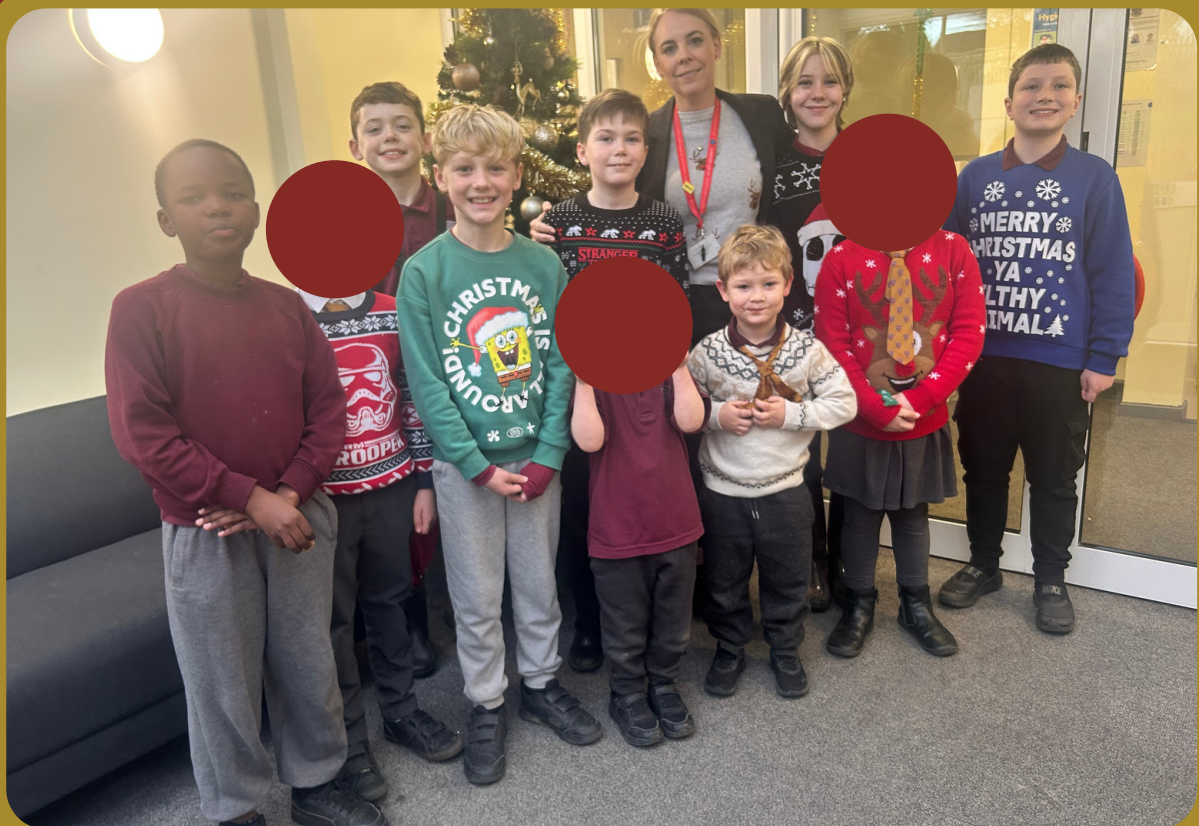

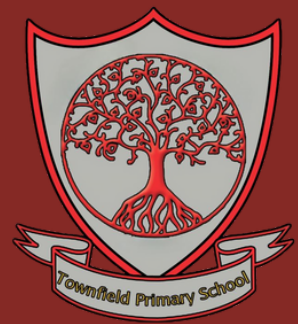

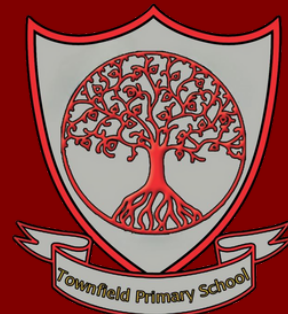
