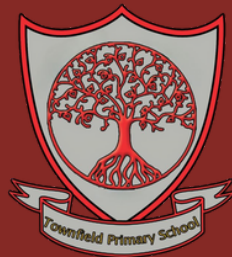

MESSAGE FROM MRS DURHAM

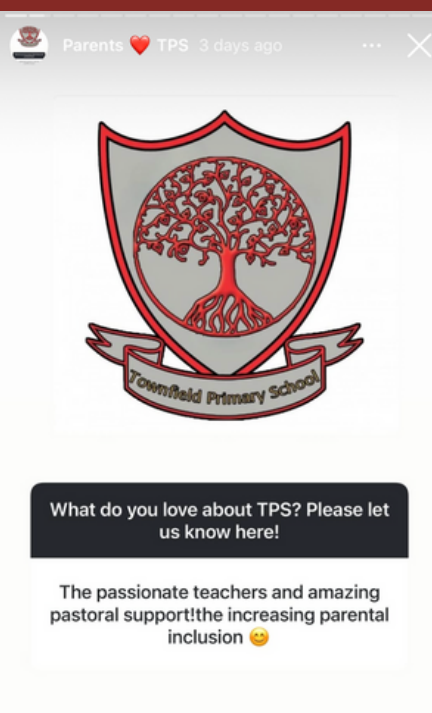

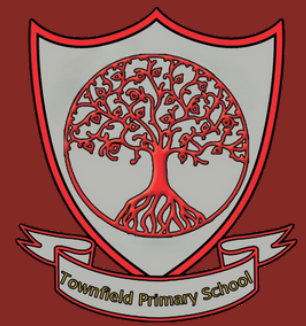


MERSEYSIDE POLICE VISIT

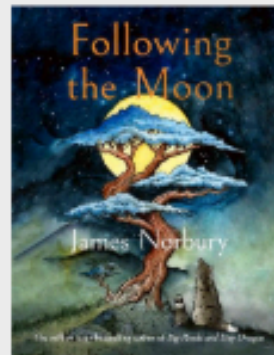
