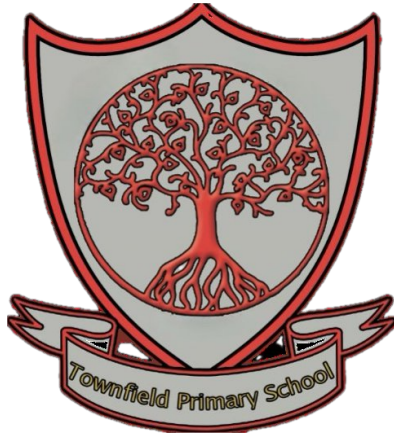

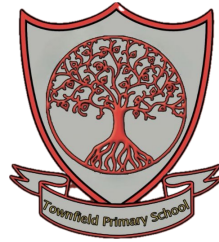

Our Focus Text:

In writing lessons this half term, we will focus on **writing short narratives, adjectives, and a variety of punctuation**. This will be based on the text *Little Red Riding Hood*. This text is a lovely story about a little girl who loves to visit her Granny's cottage in the forest. She meets a charming wolf and stops for a chat. But when she arrives at Granny's, is there something strange about her?

In **maths**, we will be solving addition and subtraction word problems, multiplication and division (equal groups, doubling, sharing and halving), fractions (halves and quarters), time (o'clock and half past), numbers to 100 (number bonds, partitioning tens and one and simple addition and subtractions).

Distinguish fabrics and threads by colour and texture.

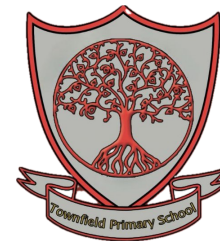

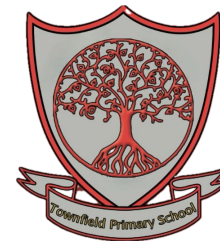

Our Focus Text: The Bog Baby and Grandad's Island

In writing lessons this half term, children will continue to explore the text 'The Bog Baby' through a creative and imaginative lens, inspiring them to write their own set of instructions on how to build their own habitat for their magical creature. We will work on using commands and descriptive language.

Following this, we will move on to our text, 'Grandad's Island' where we will create our own information texts about a jungle animal of our choice.

In **Maths**, the children will be deepening their mathematical journey by earning all about **3D shapes**. We will then move onto **fractions** where children will learn how to identify halves, thirds and quarters and also be able to find a fraction of a quantity. Following this, we will move onto **time** which will include learning how to tell and write the time to 5 minutes, sequence events and draw hands on a clock to show the time.

PSHCE & RSHE Health and Wellbeing

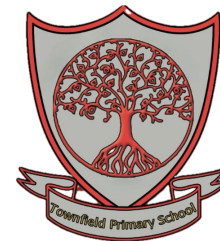
*focuses on pupils understand hygiene, healthy eating, and personal care, alongside learning basic first aid and how to keep themselves safe. Children explore similarities and differences between boys and girls, learn correct scientific vocabulary for body parts (including penis, testicles and vagina) as part of safeguarding, and build confidence in discussing their bodies and wellbeing (statutory coverage).

SCIENCE Consolidation and Review

THs term, children will have opportunities to consolidate and review their knowledge of all science topics covered in Year 2. This will ensure that these early concepts are fully mastered before KS2. They also allows the children to revisit ideas in different seasons (e.g. observing changes in spring from autumn).

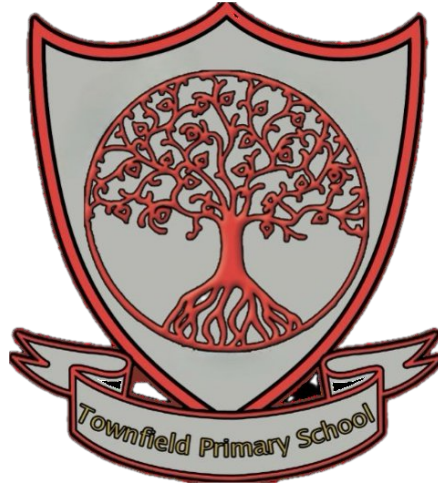

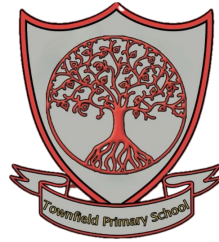

Geography Fieldwork in Local Area



Our Focus Text: The Search for our Cosmic Neighbours- Chloe Savage/ Into the Forest -Anthony Browne

This term in English, we will be exploring the wonderful book "Into the Forest." Inspired by this story, the children will be writing their own "Lost Narrative"—a tale about a character who finds themselves lost and must navigate their way back. To help make their writing as impactful as possible, we are focusing on several key language skills: word Choices, word families, super sentences.

In Maths, pupils will develop their data-handling skills by learning to read, interpret, and construct both pictograms and bar graphs, using scales to solve one-step and two-step problems. They will also dive into geometry, building foundational knowledge of angles by identifying right angles, recognizing that two right angles make a half-turn and comparing other angles to determine whether they are greater or less than a right angle.

PSHCE & RSHE - Health and Wellbeing

*focuses on helping pupils understand the importance of a balanced diet and the risks of unhealthy eating, alongside learning about physical health, hygiene, and developing healthy habits. Children also explore how to stay safe in different situations, including on holiday, and continue to reflect on their learning and share their views (statutory coverage).

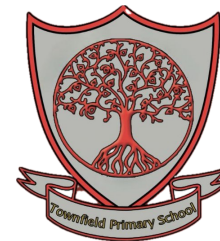

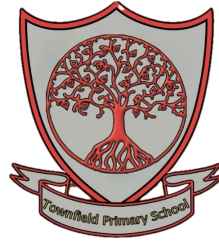

Our Focus Text: The Lost Happy Endings

In writing lessons this half term, we will continue to focus on developing both creative and persuasive writing skills. Children will write twisted narratives, exploring stories with unexpected or unusual endings to build imagination and creativity. Alongside this, they will write a persuasive letter, learning how to clearly express their opinions and influence the reader.

In maths, we will focus on **geometry, position, and movement**, learning how to plot coordinates and translate shapes. Children will also explore **Roman numerals**, learning how to read and write them.

PSHCE & RSHE Health and Wellbeing

*focuses on helping pupils understand how to stay safe in the community and make healthy choices. Children learn about physical and mental health, how bodies change as they grow, and are introduced to puberty, including how hormones cause body changes and the importance of increased personal hygiene. Pupils also reflect on their learning and share their views. (statutory coverage).

*Additional introduction of puberty and periods will be delivered.

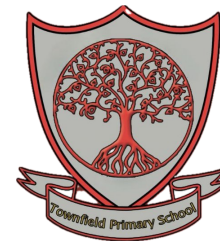

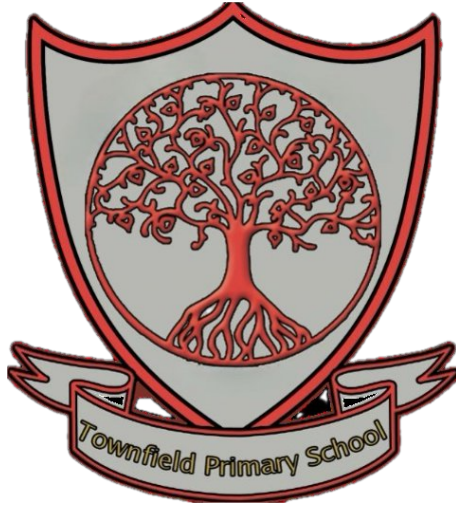

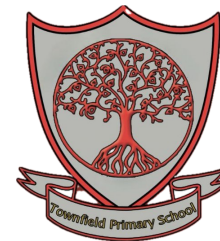

Our Focus Text:

Our Literacy lessons will be based around The Lost Book of Adventure pupils will build to an independently written survival narrative. They will use figurative language and tense-shifting to craft gripping narratives. Navigating uncharted wilderness, they build tension, describe perilous obstacles, and write authentic survival guides, learning to hook readers with sheer suspense.

In **Maths**, we will be learning about the measurements of area and perimeter before moving onto the volumes of solids and liquids.

PSHCE & RSHE - Health and Wellbeing

*focuses on pupils understanding the importance of consent, healthy lifestyles, and the benefits and risks of exercise. Children deepen their understanding of puberty, including how bodies change for reproduction, the menstrual cycle, and the correct scientific vocabulary for male and female reproductive organs. Pupils also explore protected characteristics, develop respect for differences, and reflect on their learning and view (statutory coverage).

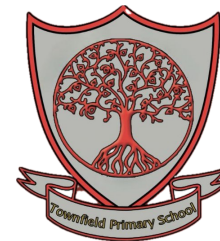

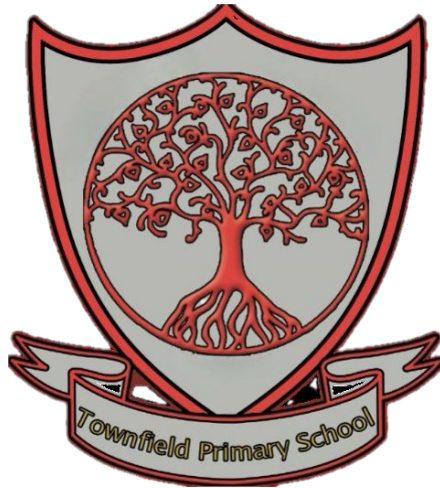

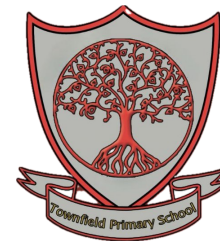

Our Focus Text:

In writing lessons this half term, we will focus on "Varmints" by Helen Ward and Marc Craste. The children will use this text to write a narrative about environmental change.. They will focus on including grammar such as expanded noun phrases, passive voice and synonyms and antonyms.

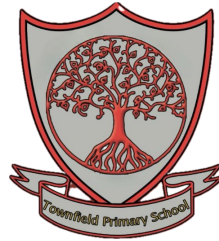
