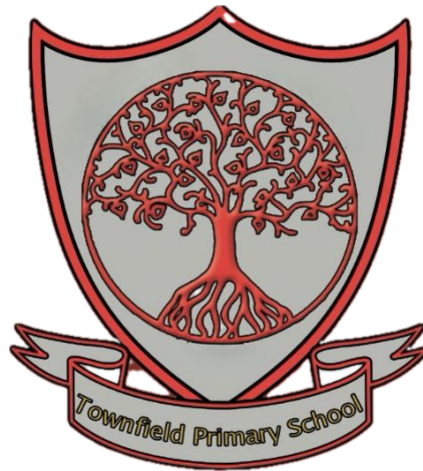

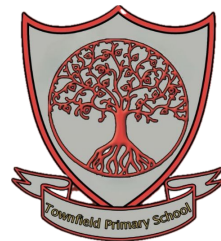


INFORMATION FOR PARENTS AND CARERS – Year 2 – Autumn 1

Our Focus Text: The Bog Baby

In writing lessons this half term, children will explore the following texts, Red Riding Hood, Grandads Island and The Proudest Blue. We will be focusing on write sentences using expanded noun phrases and the conjunctions because, but, and, when and after. We will also be learning the suffixes ed, ment, ly, less and ness. In our writing lessons we will be using exclamation marks and question marks.

In **Maths**, the children will build confidence with numbers up to 100 by practicing counting in steps of ten and breaking numbers down into tens and ones. They will use this place value foundation to compare numbers, master number bonds, and solve addition and subtraction using the standard column method. Through guided pattern exploration on 100-charts and small, varied learning steps, pupils will work toward full mathematical mastery.

PSHCE & RSHE – Relationships

*Focuses on emotional awareness through the Zones of Regulation, exploring what makes a good friend and how to build friendships, identifying personal belonging within groups and communities, acknowledging events such as the World Mental Health Day Show, Show Racism the Red Card, and Snacktember (statutory coverage)

- Know how WWI impacted on Walter Tull's life & the life of others.

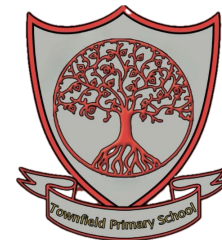
DESIGN TECHNOLOGY Mechanisms- Wheels and Axles
