Key Stage 2 Lunches

Dear Parents and Carers,

As all children return to school on Monday 8th March, we would like to offer years 3, 4, 5 and 6 some opportunities to have a hot meal. As we are working to our COVID Risk Assessment, we need to be able to feed all children yet maintain bubbles and social distancing.

In the Autumn term, Key Stage 2 were offered packed lunches and we do know that these were not very popular. From Monday 8th March, we will be offering a hot meal but to ensure we can plan appropriately for this we will need lunch numbers in advance. **If you would like your child to have a hot dinner, you must book a full week. You must pay through Sco Pay in advance.**

The lunchtime choices will include all hot dishes, deli bar and grab bags. We have introduced the grab bag option to enable the children to avoid the queue and sit at their table as quickly as possible.

The new grab bags include a sandwich/batch with a filling of ham/turkey/cheese/tuna, a dessert, drink and a piece of fruit every day with the addition of a bag of school compliant crisps on a Friday. These have proved really popular with the children since we introduced them after October half term.

The menu for the following week is always displayed on our website and included in the weekly newsletter. We will be following week 1 when we return.

I am proud of our school meal provision but as we return to 'normality', we will be reviewing school meals. You will have the opportunity to give feedback on our lunch provision and come in for taster days. We will work with all children in designing a menu which they will all enjoy.
