- Waiting on the school gate in the morning to meet the children;
- Going for a walk with the children at playtimes;
- Supporting children's emotional needs by spending time with children who visit our learning mentor;
- Spending time in classrooms and the forest school;
- Working with small groups of children to listen to them read.

An important aspect of Mabel's role is helping children to understand how to care for animals and also gain an awareness of how to be safe around dogs. We have already seen amazing results with children who have previously been frightenend of dogs, develop their confidence, to now happily stroke Mabel. However under no circumstances would we ever force children to meet Mabel. Mabel is always on a short lead when moving around school and would only freely move around classrooms, where children feel happy for this to happen.
