




## **Year2 Interactive History Lesson**

# **Year 2 Countries of the United Kingdom Fieldwork Visit**

We are pleased to inform you that as part of our Spring Geography topic, 'Countries of the United Kingdom, including coasts', we will be inviting the children to come along on a fieldwork trip on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> March. During our unit, the children have been learning about urban and rural areas on the Wirral Peninsula. We would

therefore like to give them the opportunity to make some first-hand observations to compare these two local areas. Please drop your child off and collect at the usual times.

Firstly, we will take the children by coach to Oxton Village where they will be stopping to record what the village is like and what they can see. Following this, we will travel by coach to the more rural location of Thurstaston coast. Here, they will work as 'real geographers', creating sketch maps, recording their observations and creating tally charts to compare the locations visited. Whilst on their visit to Thurstaston beach, the children will split into groups and go on a 1-hour ranger-led nature / geology walk around the coast. The children will be able to have all their questions answered by an expert, as well as learning about how the wildlife benefits from this rural location.

This trip will cost £10 per child. This will pay for the coaches, the ranger led nature walk and renting 'The Sidings'. The Sidings is a dog free picnic area at Thurstaston, which offers some shelter and toilet facilities. Please log onto Arbor to make a payment if you require your log in details please contact the school office.

We really hope your child will join us on this trip. School lunches will be provided by school but you can provide your own, if you prefer. Please come in woodland clothing, with suitable footwear and a warm (preferably waterproof) coat. Please keep in mind, we will be outdoors for the day so children will need to be dressed for our unpredictable weather! If the weather worsens, we will be given the use of the indoor lecture theatre to warm up.

For this trip to take place, we will need additional volunteers, to ensure we have the correct adult to child ratios so please let the class teacher know if you are able to help on the trip, either in person or in writing.


For this visit to go ahead, we are asking if you could contribute £10 towards the price of the tickets and transport.


