Uniform Do's & Don'ts



DO

- Wear any current uniform items until your child outgrows any of it.
- Label everything - put your child's full name in everything, not just initials. Named items should easily be found/returned to their rightful owner.
- Recycle Uniform – our fabulous FOT also run a Uniform Shop. Uniform for recycling can be passed to school or placed in the recycling bins on the playground. If you need any new items of uniform, please check our FOT Uniform Shop as there are plenty of good quality items at a fraction of the price of new items.

- For PE days (summer term) you may send your child to school with a pair of shorts to change into before their lesson. Children should attend school in joggers and not shorts due to the unpredictable nature of the British weather.

DON'T

- Do not feel the need to purchase additional uniform, unless your child requires a new one
- Send your child to school in expensive or designing clothing, particularly coats. School cannot accept any responsibility for lost or damaged clothing.
- Let your child attend school without the correct uniform on the correct day, particularly on Woodland Learning days. Unfortunately, children who do not attend with waterproof overclothing and wellies will not be allowed to participate for health and safety reasons.
